Scale of LoMap: Approximately two miles wide & four miles long, about eight of NYC's 378 square miles. 20 blocks per mile above Houston St. 1 inch = ± 350 yards. NYC is on the Atlantic Flyway & in the Hudson River Valley Bioregion. Not every site is appropriate for all ages. NYC changes constantly, so call the sites before making a special trip.
